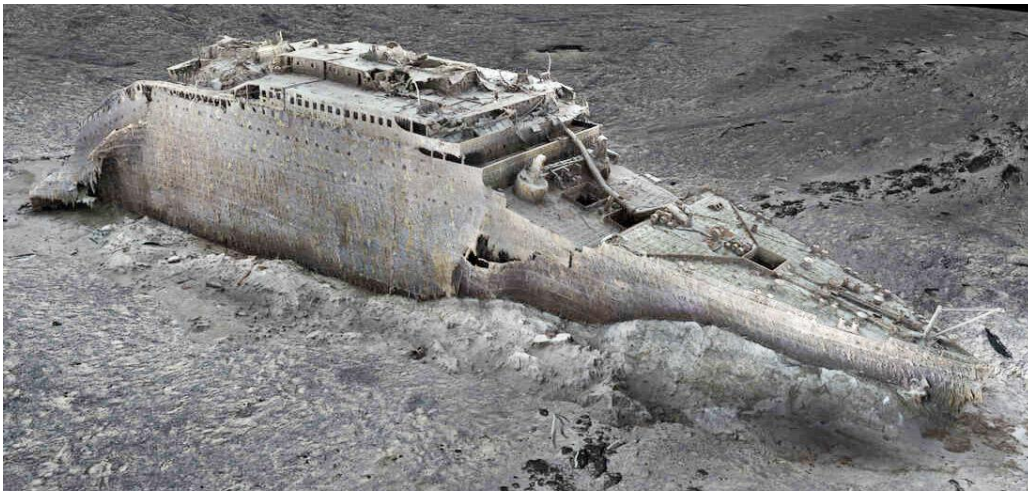

The Titanic

- What might have been

As with most catastrophes there are usually a number of factors to blame. The sinking of the Titanic was no exception.

On April 14-15, 1912, the Titanic, then the largest ocean liner in service, struck an

iceberg in the North Atlantic Ocean during its maiden voyage from Southampton, England, to New York City.

The ship's starboard side scraped along the iceberg, causing significant damage to the hull.

The ship began to take on water, and despite attempts to save it, the Titanic sank less than three hours after the collision, with over 1,500 people perishing.
