The Golden Hind

The Golden Hind was the first British ship to sail around the world. In Sir Francis Drake's epic voyage he acted as a privateer and collected enough treasure for the Queen to pay of the national debt. (I bet our current government would wish for a Privateer today!!)

He departed with a crew of 80 and returned with 56 during a voyage that started in 1577 and ended in 1580.
All off this in a boat that was only 102 foot long.
