Described as one of the most beautiful and unique sculpture parks in the UK, Sculpture by the Lakes, situated near Dorchester, is a place where you can experience art, not merely view it. Set in 26 acres alongside the river Frome, the park has many meandering paths beside the lakes with plenty of places to stop and admire the views and fabulous sculptures.

All the paths are grass around the Sculpture Park and gardens so we suggest shoes suitable for walking. Be aware also that sometimes the grass can be slippery especially if it has rained.

About the sculptor

Simon Gudgeon (born 1958) is a British sculptor specialising in large pieces for public display, usually in bronze, but also sometimes glass or stainless steel. A number of his works are in public collections, including Isis, displayed in **Hyde Park**, London.
